Fresh and juicy non-alcoholic sparkling wine made with grapes from Rudesheim, one of Germany’s renowned Riesling regions. Green apple, pear, and a tingly touch of Riesling spice. Palate clearing, slate minerality on the finish make this easy to drink and keep drinking.

Oddbird Sparkling Rosé

Silky, well-balanced and rather dry sparkling rosé from the Languedoc-Roussillon region of France. The sparkling rosé is made from Syrah which creates notes of summer berries, green apples and citrus. All-natural colour. The sparkling rosé is matured for 12 months before being gently liberated from alcohol.

Leitz Eins Zwei Zero Riesling

Serena Mode o.o Sauvignon Blanc

Oddbird GSM (Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre)

A silky, mature and dry red wine from Saint-Chinian in South of France, harvest in 2020 and characterized by its acidity and earthy notes with fruity touches. GSM is made from Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre & Carignan, creating layers with different complexities starting with red and black fruits and a sharp tannic entrance, followed by more matured fruits and spices and finishing with a nice dryness. Liberated from alcohol.
